

# AMENDMENT TO THE DEVELOPMENT CHARGES BACKGROUND STUDY

March 20<sup>th</sup>, 2018

#### **Township of Beckwith**

#### **Development Charges By-Law Amendment Background Study**

#### Introduction

On May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2014, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Beckwith approved By-Law No. 2014-16 to implement a Development Charges By-Law for the Township which came into effect June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2014.

Furthermore, on July 7<sup>th</sup>, 2015, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Beckwith approved By-Law No. 2015-21 to amend the public works component of the Development Charges By-Law for the Township.

And furthermore, on June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2016, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Beckwith approved By-Law No. 2016-23 to amend the fire services component of the Development Charges By-Law for the Township.

And furthermore, on November 7<sup>th</sup>, 2017, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Beckwith approved By-Law No. 2017-32 to amend the fire services and public works components of the Development Charges By-Law for the Township.

Under the *Development Charges Act*, 1997 (the Act), the By-Law can remain in place for a maximum of five (5) years. By-Law No. 2014-16 will expire June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019.

Development Charges assist in funding growth-related capital projects.

Beckwith Council in consultation with the Roads Department has determined the need to upgrade the surface treat on the 6<sup>th</sup> Line and Glenashton Road from gravel to LCB and desires that the projects be completed in 2018. The project listing in the Report for Development Charges Study dated April 2014, will be amended to include the 6<sup>th</sup> Line and Glenashton Rd.

The purpose of this Background Study is to identify the proposed amendments to By-Law No. 2014-16.

#### **Development Charges By-Law Amendment Process**

The Act requires a municipality to follow the same process for an amendment to a By-law as it does for the consideration of a new By-law. Section 10 through 18 of the Act outlines this process and the governing roles and responsibilities. The requirements include:

- 1. Completing a Development Charge Background Study (amendment);
- 2. Passing of a Development Charge By-Law (amendment) within one year of the completion of the background study;
- 3. Notice of the public meeting at least 20 days in advance of the public meeting date;
- 4. Background Study available to the public at least two (2) weeks prior to the public meeting;
- 5. Hold a public meeting prior to the passing of the By-law (amendment); and

6. Notice of passage of the By-law (amendment) within 20 days of the passage of the By-law.

Section 10(2) sets out the municipal requirement to complete the background study prior to the passage of a By-law or amendment. The background study must include:

- 1. Estimate of the amount, type and location of development to which the amendment applies;
- 2. Eligible growth-related costs to which the development charge By-law (amendment) relates:
- 3. Component to which the development charge By-law (amendment) relates; and
- 4. Examination of the long term capital and operating costs for the capital infrastructure required.

This document serves as the Background Study required under Section 10 of the Act. The Township of Beckwith completed a Background Study in April 2014 with an addendum in June 2015, second addendum in June 2016 and a third addendum in November of 2017.

The 2014 Study is still applicable as there have been no significant changes to the amount and type and location of development.

#### **Scope of the Proposed Amendment**

#### Roads System Amendment

The proposed amendment will alter the Roads System component of the Study by making the following changes to Table 15:

The proposed By-law will not alter or change any other provision of the By-law or result in any development in the Township being subject to higher development charges that those currently contained in By-Law No. 2014-16.

The public meeting is scheduled for May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building at 1702 9<sup>th</sup> Line Beckwith. Notification of the public meeting will be published in the Carleton Place Gazette on April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2018. The notice was also made available on the Township website: www.twp.beckwith.on.ca

The Background Study is available to the public on April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2018. If Council approves the proposed amendment, the Township will complete the requirements outlined in the Act.

#### Recommendations

It is recommended that the Township proceed to amend the Background Study of By-Law No. 2014-16 to:

Adjust the listing of Roads Projects to include the 6<sup>th</sup> Line and Glenashton Rd.
